What is the Apex Park and Recreation District Foundation?

The Apex Park and Recreation District Foundation is a non-profit 501(c) (3) organization whose purpose is to support the Apex Park and Recreation District's efforts to deliver quality community recreation. This is achieved through the efforts of a 15-member volunteer board - civic and business leaders with diverse backgrounds and a strong tradition of community service. Over the years, the Foundation has completed a wide range of projects - building park pavilions and playgrounds, purchasing equipment for programs, helping meet transportation needs for youth and seniors, renovating facilities, and much more. The Foundation's spectrum of projects is broad, but there is one common theme: providing a significant and lasting benefit to the local community.

How can you help?

You can become a Legacy Partner! You may provide for the Apex Park and Recreation District Foundation by either modifying your present Will (a codicil) or making a new Will or by including the Apex Park and Recreation District Foundation in your Revocable Living Trust or as an insurance beneficiary. All Legacy Partner donations will directly benefit community recreation through the Apex Park and Recreation District Endowment Fund. After your lifetime, Apex Park and Recreation District Foundation receives your gift.

Legacy Partnership Recognition

All Legacy Partners will be recognized with their name inscribed on the Legacy Partner wall, located at the Apex Center, the District's flagship facility. In addition, Legacy Partners will be recognized once per year in the Apex Park and Recreation District activity guide and on the Apex Park and Recreation District Foundation website, foundation.apexprd.org.



Legacy Partner Options and Definitions

There are a number of possible options for planned giving. We would be happy to discuss details or answer any questions you, your estate planner, or your attorney may have.

BEQUEST- After making adequate provisions in your Will for your family, you may want to include the Apex Park and Recreation District Foundation as a recipient of part of your estate. This may be done as a specific amount or percentage of your estate. A gift of cash, securities, life insurance or property can greatly impact community recreation and provide you with significant income tax and estate tax advantages. You may find the following sample language helpful while creating your planned giving. You may want to consult an attorney for legal advice.



Sample language:

I give and bequeath to the Apex Park and Recreation District Foundation, a Colorado 501(c) (3) non-profit organization, tax # 23-7327222 the sum of \$_____.

I give and bequeath to the Apex Park and Recreation District Foundation, a Colorado 501(c) (3) non-profit organization, tax # 23-7327222 _____% of my gross estate as determined for estate tax purposes.

LIFE INSURANCE- It is relatively easy to transfer the ownership and beneficiary of a life insurance policy to the Apex Park and Recreation District Foundation. A paid-up, partially paid policy or a beneficiary designation can provide a much larger gift than you may have imagined and provide a substantial income tax deduction.

Sample language:

I give and bequeath to the Apex Park and Recreation District Foundation, a Colorado 501(c) (3) non-profit organization, tax # 23-7327222 the following life insurance policy in full or a partial designation of _____%.

REAL PROPERTY- A gift of real estate can free you from obligation of caring for property that is no longer useful to you. It will also provide a valuable benefit to the entire community through the Apex Park and Recreation District Foundation. All real property must be approved by the APRD Foundation

Sample language:

I give and bequeath to the Apex Park and Recreation District Foundation, a Colorado 501(c) (3) non-profit organization, tax # 23-7327222 the following property, _____.

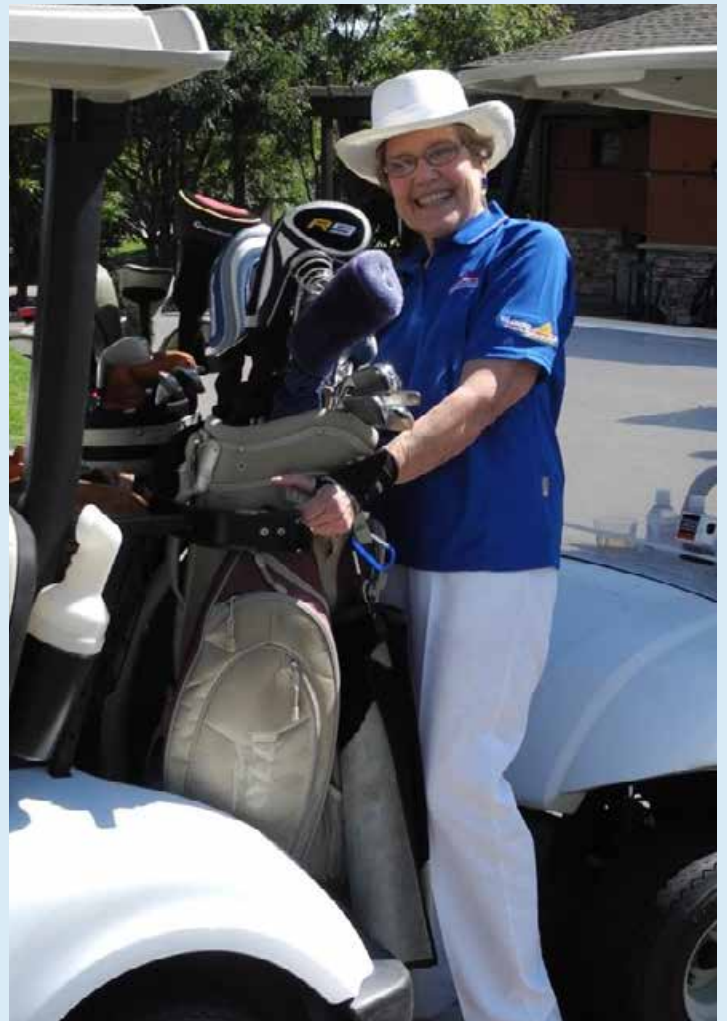
